We have done lots of learning this week, including...

English – We have been introduced to this half-term's topic—The Secret Garden. We have read the story, explored the characters, written a book review and created a story map to retell the story. We have also started to learn about prepositions in grammar.

Maths – We have been calculating fractions of amounts (e.g. $\frac{2}{3}$ of 18) using arrays and we created a fraction wall and then used it to identify equivalent fractions.
