What have we been doing?

Phonics	How 'w' and 'qu' change the sound that 'a', 'ar' and 'or' make in some words.
English	This week we have begun learning the text map for 'Trust me, Jack's Beanstalk Stinks' by heart. See We have compared this to the traditional story, written speech for the characters. We also have looked at conjunctions and we did a reading comprehension on the cycle of a bean plant.
Maths	We have been telling the time on analogue clocks, in hours, half past, quarter past and quarter to.
Music	We continued rehearsing our Jack and the Beanstalk performances. We are excited to be performing next week.
RE	We thought about what symbols represent Easter to us.
Art	We had lots of fun mixing primary and secondary colours to see what colours we would make using paint.
Science	We started our topic of living things, we looked at the different categories we can put animals in.
Geography	We learned the continents and oceans, locating them on a map, and began exploring the Amazon Rainforest as a habitat, locating it on a world map, too.
