What have we been doing?

Phonics	How 'w' and 'qu' change the sound that 'a', 'ar' and 'or' make in some words.
English	We are now performing our 'Trust me, Jack's beanstalk stinks' text map brilliantly and have used it to help write some brilliant character descriptions and begin innovating their own stories. The children showed great progress in their reading comprehension on vegetables.
Maths	Time continued apace, extending our learning to five minutes past and to the hour. We have been consolidating all our time-telling learning towards the end of the week.
Music	We performed our Jack and the Beanstalk pieces to the class. It was lovely.
RE	We went on an Easter egg hunt to find the parts of the Easter story then put them together and told it.

Geography	We have ventured into the tropical Amazon Rainforest and the children have written some brilliant paragraphs about the features of this extraordinary and endangered habitat.
