Learning update

We have now begun our final half term of this school and the children are all very excited to begin the 'chocolate' topic.

Our English lessons have started to look at biography writing. The children have read a variety of biographies and looked at the key features of this style of writing. We have also had a go at writing the opening paragraph of a biography about me!

In maths lessons, we have spent time looking at a variety of areas which the children continue to find tricky. We have spent time considering how we go about adding and subtracting fraction, what to do with an answer which is a top heavy fraction and how to deal with mixed number fractions. The children also looked at missing number problems and balancing style problems which use the = symbol in the middle. It was really beneficial to devote some time to these tricky areas.

We began our topic lessons by thinking about what we already know about chocolate (apart from the fact that it makes clothes too tight!).

In our RE lessons we are considering the concept of equality and its importance in the Sikh religion. We spent time discussing whether 'equal' meant 'the same'. As always, we had some really thoughtful discussion.
