Another busy week in Year 1 😊

Phonics	<p>Lots of new phonemes/graphemes this week</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">o as in go i as in tiger a as in acorn e as in he/me/she/we</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">New tricky words too!</p>
English	<p>Instructions: The features of instructions. How to make a jam sandwich</p> <p>Florence Nightingale writing – questions to ask a superhero</p> <p>Adding 'and' to sentences to make them longer.</p>
Maths	<p>The Numberline: counting forwards and backwards to 10. Finding 1 less and 1 more on the numberline.</p> <p>Showing numbers greater than and less than on the numberline.</p> <p>In Maths we have started to look at part part whole. We used double sided counters (red one side and yellow on the other). We had a handful which we threw down. We looked at how many red (one part), how many yellow (another part) and then talked about the whole (all together). We then progressed to look at the part part whole model....</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> </div> <p>We looked at 7 and found different ways to share 7 into 2 parts. Lots of practical work this week!</p>
TOPIC	<p style="text-align: center;">Florence Nightingale</p> <p>We talked about superheroes linking this with Florence Nightingale.</p>
RE	<p style="text-align: center;">Belonging: Judaism</p> <p>We have been talking about Mitzvahs (good deeds) that we could do.</p>
PE	<p style="text-align: center;">PE was on Thursday with Mrs Crook.</p> <p>(A group of children did some gross-motor balance work on Tuesday PM).</p>
Computing	<p>We drew superheroes on a simple drawing programme on the laptops.</p>
Science	<p>We learnt all about our 5 senses. We listened to and identified sounds. We smelt and identified smells in pots. We talked about our lunches. We played 'I spy'. We played 'Guess what it in the bag' using touch to find out!</p>
