


Year 1 Learning Update 17.11.2023

English	<p>Instructions: Ordering instructions: How to brush your teeth (don't rinse, it washes the fluoride off!)</p> <p>Question sentences to ask a nurse</p>
Maths	<p>Writing number sentences using the part part whole model....</p>  <p>Finding fact families. If a part is 2 and a part is 3, the whole is 5. So we know; $2+3=5$, $3+2=5$, $5=2+3$, $5=3+2$ Bonds within 10 ie $3+4$, $6+2$ Number bonds to 10 (Hearts in Love) $9,1$ $8,2$ $6,4$ etc....</p>
