What have we been doing?

Phonics	Learning why some words have -ey for the sound /ee/.
English	The class have blown us away with their incredible enthusiasm and writing stamina this week. We can't wait to read their independently written invent texts.
Maths	Our fractions learning has covered halves, quarters, thirds, what makes a whole and unit fractions.
PSHE	We identified the differences between male and female mammals.
RE	The children drew symbols to represent the resurrection.
Art	The children created some colourful collages, accurately depicting the Packhorse bridge in Moulton.
Science	What makes an animal living, dead or never alive?
Geography	We identified the eight cardinal points on a compass, why it points north, and discussing how it would be useful to find our way if lost in a rainforest, and used it to find objects on a treasure map.
