English	<p>Handwriting: Joining- 'easy words': lad, add, toad, data</p> <p>Writing the story of The Very Hungry Caterpillar – we completed this. What a lot of writing from the children!</p>
Maths	<p>Mass: Heavier and lighter  Measuring mass  Comparing mass</p>
