We can't believe we are almost half-way through this half term. The children are working hard on new topics, such as Judaism and the legacy of Ancient Greek medicine, as well as consolidating all of our learning this year to ensure they are confident and prepared for their next step in Key Stage 2.



This week's learning in Year 3 has included:

- Maths - interpreting and drawing bar charts, consolidation of money, including finding change in pounds and pence, problem-solving and reasoning based on organising a party for Tutankhamen
- English - creating and describing a mythical creature, non-fiction whole class reading of an information text about Stone Age meals
- Science - investigating reflective materials
- Art - creating gemstones for a piece of Ancient Greek jewellery
- RE - the Bar Mitzvah in Judaism PSHE - the effect of media on food choices
- Topic - Who was Hippocrates? His early life and why he is the 'father of medicine'
- Computing - using repetition (loops) in a programme
- French - using articles (un/une/des and le/la/las), to ask for a wish from the genie in our French story of Aladdin
