

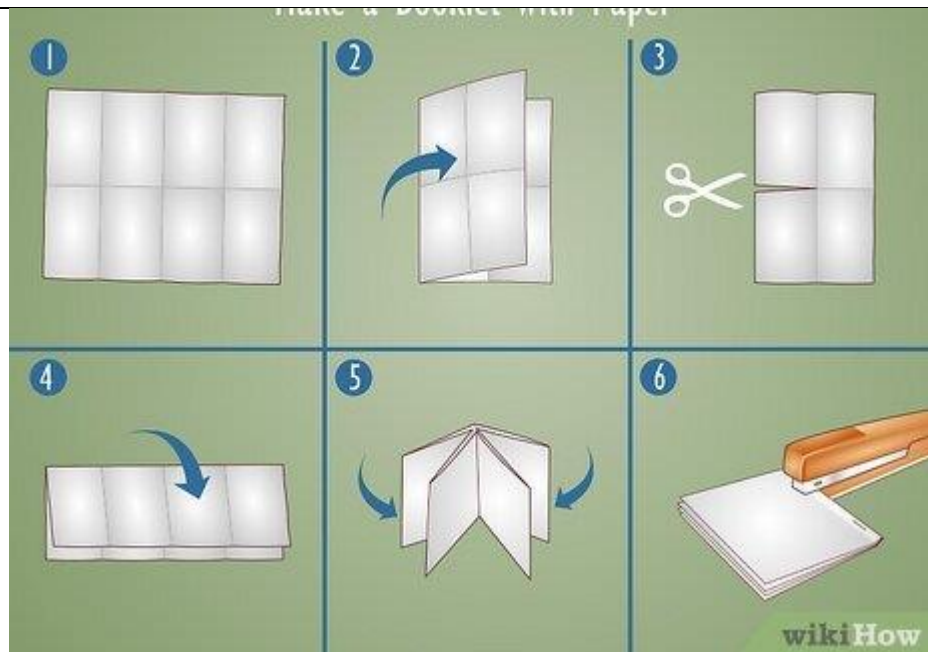
# Year 1 Learning Update 27.03.2026

## What we've been learning this week:

1. Fold a sheet of paper in half 3 times to divide it into eighths, then unfold it.
2. Fold the paper in half, short edge to short edge.
3. Turn the paper so the folded edge is facing you.
4. Cut the vertical crease until you reach the intersection with the horizontal crease.
5. Unfold the page again, then fold it in half, long edge to long edge.
6. Push the short edges together with the cut edge facing you to create book pages.
7. Flatten the booklet and staple the folded edge to hold it together.
